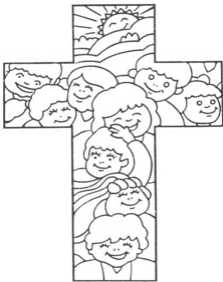
## “Kids Can for Christ” is BACK!

Our Goal: Collect 3000 food items.

## PASTOR CORNERED

As many of you already know, we at FCUMC are part of a connectional denomination, which means that all United Methodist churches are linked in ministry in various ways. Because of that, we are able to help live and spread the gospel in places that we could not even think about going by ourselves. We do that through our Conference apportionments, which support Conference and general church ministries. Last year we contributed \$250,000 toward this support. Below is a letter of appreciation from Bishop James Swanson.

“In these economically challenging times we are living through, I want to thank you personally for faithfully responding to the 2009 ministry and missional needs of your United Methodist Church by paying 100% of the funds apportioned to your local church. The money given by your church has extended the touch of Jesus into the lives of many. I lift up to you just a few of the many ministry opportunities in 2009 that happened because of your generous hearts.

- You helped 3026 children and youth to attend a Holston Conference Camp this past summer where 305 or 10% made first-time professions of faith and 847 (another 28%) expressed a rededication of their faith. You created memories that being with Jesus can be fun.
- You helped provide six grants to local churches to begin or enhance young adult ministries through their church and provided four grants to assist young adults to participate in mission experiences. You created renewed hope in these churches that they can reach out to the young adults in their communities.
- You helped the W.S. Hight Penal After-Care Empowerment (PACE) Agency assist clients (primarily women) as they are released from jail to re-establish their lives in the community and find

meaningful employment so that they can support themselves and their children. You gave hope that Jesus and God’s people have not given up on them.

- You sponsored an event that helped equip laity and pastors of 100 of our smaller membership churches to Offer Christ and Make Disciples in their communities. Many left with a new-found encouragement to go back and make a difference for Jesus.
- You helped congregations that needed help in paying their pastors’ salaries through the Equitable Compensation Fund. Need I say how grateful the pastors and their families are?
- You helped launch new churches for new people and helped to call many to reconnect with Christ. Many of these people are first time confessions of faith.
- You helped over 700 men experience the joy of being a man whose life is dedicated to Christ and for some as one participant declared “You have re-established my faith in Christ and the Church.”

My sisters and brothers, we have thousands of stories of many lives being changed, rescued, delivered and set free to serve Christ. I wish I could relate them all, but I hope this gives you some idea of the difference your dollars make. On behalf of the new persons in Christ, children and youth filled with great memories, men who aren’t ashamed to claim Christ, women that now walk in freedom and dignity, pastors and families whose needs are being met, and church members who are Offering Christ, I thank you.”

### What is Lent?

The season of Lent is a traditional time in the church when we give special attention to repenting for failures and sin as a way to focus on the need for God's grace. Throughout Lent we encourage prayer, fasting, and giving of our time and gifts as we approach Easter. The introspective feel of Lent is a preparation to celebrate God's marvelous redemption at Easter, and the resurrected life that we live, and hope for, as Christians.

### What is Ash Wednesday?

The Christian season of Lent spans 40 weekdays and begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17. On this day we will have a 7:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. brief (30 minute), but meaningful service in the chapel. You are also invited to a 6:30 p.m. worship service in the sanctuary. The Chancel Choir will provide music for this service. As a part of each worship time, there will be the imposition of the ashes (the sign of the cross on the forehead) for those who wish to receive it as a reminder of our sinfulness before God. Childcare will be available for children birth through three year-old Sunday School for the evening service. All small groups that normally meet at 6:30 p.m. will not meet that evening.

We hope you will be able to begin the journey to Easter by joining us for worship on Ash Wednesday, February 17.

### New Sermon Series: 24 Hours that Changed The World

No single event in human history has received more attention than the suffering and crucifixion of Jesus of Nazareth. His last 24 hours changed the world.
